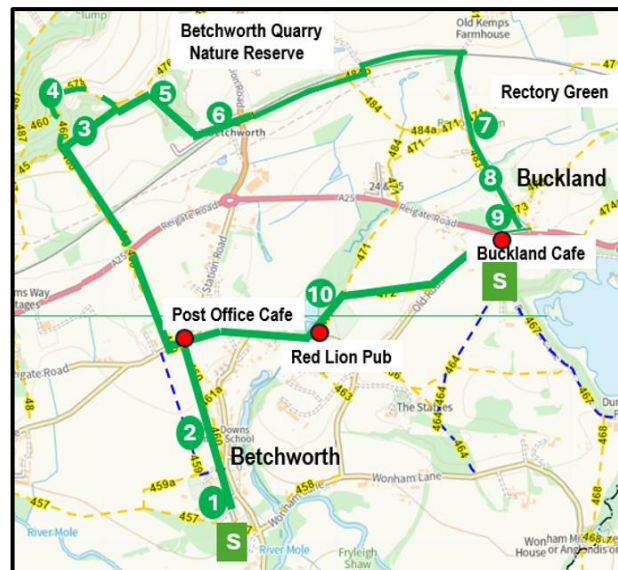




Invitation to Join the Betchworth & Buckland Nature Trail Team

Over the past few years, our 4Bs Nature Group has grown to over 130 members and become a thriving community sharing an interest and concern for nature. With financial support from Betchworth Parish Council, the Betchworth & Buckland Society and the Community Lottery Fund we have cultivated over 4000m² of wildflowers, created ponds and other wildlife habitats, surveyed butterflies, wildflowers, birds and amphibians, and published three Nature Magazines celebrating our efforts.

We want to continue to help residents connect to and appreciate the nature around us. In 2026, we are beginning a new project to create the **Betchworth & Buckland Nature Trail** — a 6.5km circular walk linking wildflower meadows, ancient woodland, chalk grassland, village greens, ponds and wetlands. The trail follows existing footpaths and lanes and connects people directly with the living landscape on their doorstep.



A trail is only as strong as the people who care for it, so we are forming a **B&B Nature Trail Team** of local custodians who will help care for and gently steward the route. Members of the Team might walk a familiar stretch of the trail from time to time to check the path and report maintenance needs. They will observe and report seasonal changes in plants and wildlife, share photos of observations and join occasional group conservation activities. Ultimately, they will be helping our most precious natural asset to flourish for future generations.
